

## Blogger Assignment

### Assignment Goals:

A great deal of both our class text and discussion has included concern and specifics regarding online communication. As our society continues to embrace more and more avenues for communication and composition taking place in new media, it is important to reflect on our own communication habits in online settings.

With this in mind, each class member will set up his or her own blog and will converse with other bloggers in the class. I hope this assignment will allow you to put some of our theoretical discussions into action.

I will give everyone time in class to do this work.

If any questions arise after we have set up blogs, please refer to the handbook I loaded on our blackboard site under the "Assignment" button.

**1-Set up a new blog** (we'll do this in class on Mar. 11). You may also wish to post a short "hello" or greeting post.

**2-Add your group members** and me as members to your blog. Will need to send email invitations to those people and will need to respond to the two or three invitation messages sent to you. (My email is [Jennifer\\_almjeld@owens.edu](mailto:Jennifer_almjeld@owens.edu)). Directions for adding blog members are included in the Blogger handbook posted on Blackboard.

**3-Post a response** of some sort **about chapter 10** to your blog. Your post should be about **250 words** and should highlight something about the chapter that affected you personally (you liked it, disagreed with it, had trouble understanding parts of it, etc.). Your post is due **by 6 p.m. Sunday, Mar. 25.**

**4-Respond at least three** times to your partners' **blogs**. Your responses are to be posted **by class time Sunday, April 1.**
